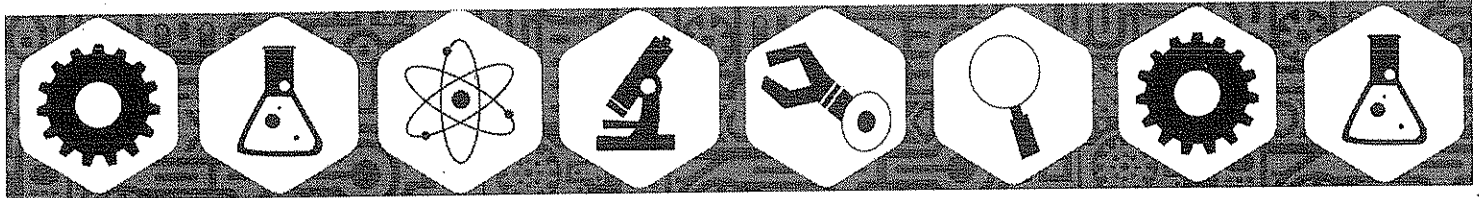

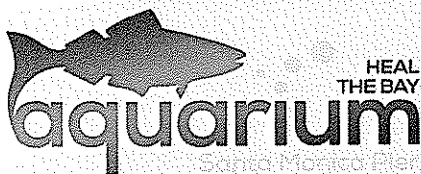

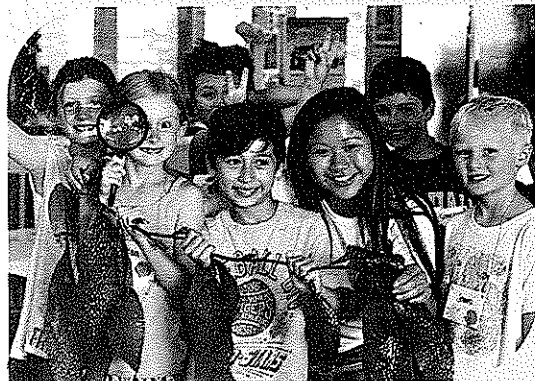

How much will Scouting cost?

The registration fee to join the BSA is \$24 per year. You also have the option to subscribe to Boy's Life Magazine for an additional \$12, which is mailed directly to your son at home every month.
