Know Someone Perfect for McKinley PTA?

We are looking for interested candidates for next year's PTA Board. If you'd like to get more involved in McKinley school life, if you want to play a more active role in planning next year's school season, if you have a skill suited to these openings, or if you know of someone you think we should ask, we'd love to hear from you.

Please don't wait - McKinley needs you!

All terms are one year (July-June), and there is a term limit of two years in each position. You may nominate for any position, even if the current holder of that seat has not served two years. **Seats for which the current officeholder is termed out are marked with an asterisk, but all seats are open.**

President: The President calls and chairs meetings of the PTA Board and General Assemblies. The President works with the Board and the Principal to set the calendar, establish the budget, and coordinate activities of the Board and Association. The President also attends PTA Council meetings monthly and School Board meetings as needed, and is McKinley's parent liaison to our District.

*Executive VP: The EVP chairs meetings when the President cannot, gets the permits for events, attends meetings with the President, and assists the President and serves in his/her stead as needed.

1st VP Education and Literacy: The VP of Education & Literacy oversees PTA programs like family nights (math, science, art), Movie Nights, Reflections, & the Beautification & Sustainability Committee.

2nd VP Communications: The VP of Communication is responsible for coordinating communication, including overseeing the chairs for Wednesday Folders, eblasts, the newsletter; assisting event chairs with promotion as needed; and promoting PTA meetings.

*3rd VP Fundraising: The VP of Fundraising is responsible for coordinating event chairs and overseeing all fundraising events. Responsibilities include helping to set the calendar, select fundraisers, and give input into budget creation.

4th VP Hospitality: The VP of Hospitality is responsible for events like the Kindergarten Back to School meet & greet, teacher luncheons, Family Picnic, and refreshments for PTA meetings.

Secretary: The Recording Secretary keeps accurate, concise and permanent records of all meetings of the PTA and the executive board.

*Treasurer: The treasurer is the authorized custodian of all the McKinley PTA funds; duties also include keeping records and preparing reports to comply with local, state and federal laws.

*Financial Secretary: The financial secretary receives, records and deposits all monies collected by the PTA.

*Auditor: The auditor examines all financial transactions for the three reporting periods of the year.

Historian: The historian tracks volunteers hours, maintains event reports, details and photos, and completes an end of year report.

All of the above officers have a vote on the Board and attend Board meetings and General meetings, which usually means about two meetings a month.
