Many grade level teams are collaborating together regularly to plan units of study, plan lesson plays, review student progress, set student goals and share resources, ideas and strategies with one another. Teachers have been implementing a variety of strategies into their daily schedules such as close reading with non-fiction text, academic conferencing, CGI math strategies (with real world application), differentiated guided reading groups, readers' workshop, writers' workshop, and much, much more!

We're getting ready for grade 3-5 SBAC (state testing). Our testing window begins May 4-May 20. Testing will begin promptly at 8:45 am. Debbie Stern will be sending parents updates, and you can also see your child's teacher for more testing information.

A HUGE shout out to all of our AMAZING parent volunteers who help our school community. It's nice to see you on campus helping in the garden, classroom, cafeteria, field trips, etc.! We appreciate all you do and we don't thank you enough!

I had the privilege of attending Dr. Noguera's equity review presentation last week at SAMOHI. His presentation will be available on the district website soon. Principals will be getting school reports in June. All principals will be attending a 3 day equity workshop in June with Dr. Noguera and his team. We will review our school report, look at trends/patterns, review strengths and areas of need, then develop a plan to help close the opportunity gap for students. Once I have more info, I will share the details with you.

Not returning next year? Please make sure to let the office know. We're beginning to make plans for next year, and we keep a close eye on our enrollment numbers. Thank you for communicating next year's plans with us.

Dear Parents,

The McKinley administration and staff will soon begin class placements for next year. We will do this based on our projected enrollment for the 2016-17 school year. Class formation is a complicated and thoughtful process. Every class is balanced in order to provide a nurturing environment where your child can grow academically and emotionally.

We would like to give you the opportunity to give us some information about your child that you feel will be helpful in determining his/her placement. Below are guidelines about the type of information we will accept:

- > Describe the type of environment in which your child performs best.
- Class configurations are determined based on enrollment and <u>it may be determined that combination classes</u> <u>need to be created in ANY GRADE LEVEL</u>. You may include any relevant information here if you have a preference
- Do not include names of specific children with whom your child should be placed. However, if there is particular dynamic between your child and another student that we should consider, please include this information.
- > Use this form for placement information, any separate letters regarding placement will be discarded.

The administration will make the final decision as to placement of all children. All information to be considered during placement should be contained on this form. <u>Please do not request a meeting regarding your child's placement</u>. You will receive notification in the mail regarding your child's placement a week before school starts. WE DO NOT POST CLASS LISTS.

All McKinley teachers are highly qualified and can meet the needs of all students. If you have any concerns about your child within the first three weeks of school please do not call the office and ask for a change of placement or a meeting with an administrator. Please contact your child's teacher directly to set up a parent /teacher conference to try and resolve your concerns. Once three weeks have passed, and you have had a parent/ teacher conference, if you still have concerns you may contact an administrator to arrange a meeting with administration, yourself, and your child's teacher to discuss the matter further.



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
