Dear Families:
Wow! The last couple of weeks have been busy! Students enjoyed participating in the 300+ club for jog-a-thon and enjoyed hot chocolate and snacks (thanks to all volunteers who assisted with this event). We also had our jog-a-thon limo ride on Friday to Mulligan's for select students. We all enjoyed the limo ride, miniature golf, \& laser tag! It was fun for me to chaperone and be a part of this fun-filled event! Any time I get to spend with the kiddos is a good day! Special thanks to Coach AD and Coach Danny for chaperoning as well.

As I'm visiting classrooms, it's been nice to see students working with their buddy readers. Upper grade students are matched with primary grade students and they read to one another. This is a great opportunity for upper grade students to be role models for the little ones. The students have been working with their buddies all year long and it's great to see the bond between buddies growing and becoming stronger.

Our art classes have been working on some AMAZING projects this year. As I observe the students during art class, I'm so proud of the art skills \& talents our students possess! The art work they produce is phenomenal! The PS Arts theme this year has to do with identity and finding your "true colors." After looking at paintings by Kehinde Wiley, students drew self-portraits inspired by historical figures. The primary classes concentrated on their own photograph of movement \& rhythm inspired by Gustav Klimt. Students designed their own imaginative brand sneakers, using contour, water color \& marker techniques. Currently, students are moving forward together \& exploring community identity, through collaboration to create "sound suites" based on Nick Cave, the performance \& installation artist.

I'll be continuing lunch with the principal these last 2 months of school. Students enjoy coming to my office to have lunch and play board games, and I must admit, this is the highlight of my day as well! It's a wonderful way for me to get to know the kids a little better and for them to get to know me. And it's a great way for them to feel extra special. Students are randomly picked through a raffle (we put the MAC slips in a basket and draw names). When students are selected, the child will receive an invite via email and a hard copy will go in their backpacks, too. After our lunch date, students will receive a picture of our lunch together to take home and the picture will also be posted in the office for display. Having lunch with the students is the best part of being a principal!

We're in the process of planning for next year. As you know, we don't take teacher requests, but your input is important to us as we make classes for next year. Be sure to complete the parent input sheet and return to the office by May 6.
