We're awaiting the results to see if we're the 3 time champions! But regardless, $84 \%$ is wonderful! Thank you for participating and thank you for volunteering! What a great way to be healthy and help the environment.

Thank you to all parents who completed the 2015-2016 Parent Climate Survey (completed January 25-February 12). I appreciate you taking the time to complete the survey as your feedback is important to us ( 96 parents completed the survey). We use this information to have a better understanding of your perspective and experience at McKinley. The information is used to create goals and help us plan for the future. I shared this information with our governance committee and at the last Coffee with the Principal. $87 \%$ of the parents surveyed rated the overall quality of McKinley as good/excellent. Below are some highlights from the survey results:

## 4 Areas of Strength

Staff members \& families treat each other with respect. McKinley encourages families to volunteer.
McKinley respects \& values input provided by families.
McKinley offers students a variety of activities/courses.

## Areas of Focus

Teachers successfully show students how lessons relate to life outside of school. Students receive the support they need for academic/career planning.
The school uses family input to improve instruction.
School administrators are responsive when I have a concern.

I've had several Coffee with the Principal meetings this year and discussed safety concerns with families. I appreciate your input and feedback as you may notice some things we have not noticed. And it's important for us to have a safe school environment for all. Some of the safety issues have been addressed (i.e. lighting) and some we are in the process of addressing. The concerns related to childcare have been forwarded to the childcare staff (CREST \& SAP). Below are some of the safety concerns brought to my attention:

- Arizona fence area exposed to students
- Dismissal procedures
- Dark campus/not enough lighting
- Emergency drill training for staff and parents
- After school care and having an open campus from 3-6 pm
- K child care located in the small yard vs. the big yard
- Visitors not signing in when on campus
- Additional crossing guards
- Students using inappropriate language on the yard
